FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES ORDINANCE  
REVISED 4-16-84

1. FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES

Fire protection services shall be provided by the Stockbridge Township Fire Department on a fee basis only. Said fees shall be levied in the following manner and amounts:

1.1 RESIDENTS OF STOCKBRIDGE TOWNSHIP.

(A) Not residing within a local governmental unit separate from Stockbridge Township

Requests from such resident and receipt of such fire protection services relative to premises in the township which are not located in a separate governmental unit or personal property located anywhere within the township shall result in a run fee charged to the township based on cost.

(B) Residing within a local governmental unit separate from Stockbridge Township.

(1) Governmental units under contract with Stockbridge Township for Fire Protection.

Requests for and receipt of fire protection services by residents thereof shall result in fees charged to the governmental unit pursuant to said contract for services.

(2) Private property owners residing within a governmental unit not under contract with Stockbridge Township for Fire Protection.

The provision of fire protection services to private premises or personal property located within said separate governmental unit shall result in a fire run fee to be charged to the owner of such private property.

**1.2 RESIDENTS AND PROPERTIES OF OTHER GOVERNMENTAL UNITS OUTSIDE OF STOCKBRIDGE TOWNSHIP.**


**(A) Under Contract with Township for Fire Protection**

Fire protection services to premises or property outside Stockbridge Township shall be provided pursuant to the contract made between Stockbridge Township and such other governmental unit.

**(B) Not under contract for Fire Protection**

Fire protection shall not be provided other than pursuant to contract.
