

**ORDINANCE #203**

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TRESPASS UPON PROPERTY BELONGING TO  
STOCKBRIDGE TOWNSHIP**

The Township of Stockbridge Ordains:

**Section 1.** No person shall be allowed to assemble and/or loiter on property belonging to Stockbridge Township, including the Stockbridge Town Square, after 9:00 P.M. and prior to 6:00 A.M., unless said person(s) have authorized business with the Township or within the Town Hall and/or are attending a public meeting and/or are going to and from an office in the Town Hall which is open. Those persons who have lawful business within the Town Hall and/or are attending a meeting between the above stated hours shall use the sidewalks provided for entrance to and exit from the Town Hall.

**Section 2.** Any person in violation of the above shall be deemed to be trespassing upon such property belonging to Stockbridge Township and necessary steps will be taken as legally permissible to cause removal from such Township property of all persons in violation of the above.

**Section 3.** The Ingham County Sheriff's Department and the Stockbridge Police Department are hereby authorized to serve as agent for and

on behalf of the Township of Stockbridge who cause to be removed and/or prosecuted pursuant to all appropriate State, local laws and/or ordinances, all persons trespassing upon the Stockbridge Township property and grounds as provided above.

The above ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the Stockbridge

Township Board August 16, 1982, to be effective September 1, 1982.
