

ORDINANCE # 211

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE STOCKBRIDGE TOWNSHIP
BUILDING CODE ORDINANCE, ORDINANCE
NO. 310 AND TO ESTABLISH AND PROVIDE FOR
CIVIL INFRACTION FINES FOR VIOLATION OF THE
ORDINANCE IN ADDITION TO OTHER REMEDIES.

THE TOWNSHIP OF STOCKBRIDGE ORDAINS:

SECTION 1: The Stockbridge Township Building Code Ordinance is amended by the addition thereto of the following:

SECTION

SANCTIONS FOR VIOLATION

Any person or other entity who violates any provision of this Ordinance, including failure to obtain a permit, is responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined by Michigan law and subject to a civil fine determined in accordance with the following schedule:

1st violation within 3-year period*	\$ 50.00
2nd violation within 3-year period*	\$100.00
3rd violation within 3-year period*	\$200.00
4th or subsequent violation within 3-year period*	\$500.00

*determined on the basis of the date of violation(s).

B. For violation of all provisions of this Ordinance, the violator shall pay costs, which shall include all direct or indirect expenses to which the Township has been put in connection with the violation. A violator of this Ordinance shall also be subject to such additional sanctions, remedies, and judicial orders as are authorized under Michigan law. Each day a violation of this Ordinance continues to exist constitutes a separate violation.

SECTION 3: The remaining provisions of Ordinance No.310 and all amendments thereto are hereby ratified and reaffirmed.

SECTION 4: In the event that any provision of the within amending Ordinance for any reason is held to be unconstitutional or void, that provision shall be struck from the amendment and severed, and the remaining provisions shall be enforced according to their terms.

SECTION 5: The within amending Ordinance shall be effective 30 days after adoption and publication as provided by law.
