Section 23a of the State Construction Act of 1972, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, being Section 125.1523a of the Michigan Compiled Laws. Fee Clarifications: (Item #2 Mobil Home Unit Site)

- 1) When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites.
- 2) When setting a mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. A licensed contractor shall do all work.
- 3) When setting a mobile home or a modular home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

Plan Review Requirements:

Plans and specifications for new construction work, alteration, repair, expansion, addition, or modification work shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal. A Plan Review is required before a permit Can Be Issued.

Exception 1) Alterations and repair work determined by the electrical official to be of a minor nature.

Exception 2) Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

Exception 3) A building of use group R-3 or R-4 containing not more than 3,500 Square feet of building area.

Exception 4) Wiring or alteration to an electrical system that costs less than \$10,000.00, unless requested by administrative authority.
